Items can be dropped off in the Rec Room. Volunteers will be needed to help pack the bags once items have been collected. All items must be new. Please, no old or used items.

**General list for donated items – all items should be new**

- Soft duffel bags or backpacks
- Stuffed animals
- Coloring books and colored pencils including some for younger children (crayons melt)
- Small toys for all ages
- School supplies
- Small toiletries including travel size toothbrush/toothpaste, hotel soap and shampoo
- Items for teens/tweens: games, young-adult books, deodorant, makeup, trading cards
- Baby items - rattles, pacifiers, bibs, diapers, baby clothes
- Bibles for all ages or bible story books
- books - especially books that have been a comfort to your children
- Baseball caps, headbands, ponytail holders
- t-shirts up to adult sizes for teens
- Scarves, socks, shoes, underwear
- Earrings, bracelets (can be handcrafted)
- Games: Handheld, Travel (checkers, connect four), deck of cards
- Small photo album
- Pictures drawn by younger children, notes of encouragement (consider a note card from church?)
- Sports cups with straws
- Straws

- Inflatable balls (beach) or small soft balls

**Toddler bag** - (note toddler size\_\_\_\_\_ and gender M\_\_\_ F\_\_\_)

- Sippy non-spill cup
- Travel size wipes
- Size 4 or 5 diaper or pull-up
- 1 pair of pajamas
- Small soft toy, inflatable or small soft ball
- Bubbles
- t-shirt
- underwear - 3 T and up
- socks
- note or picture drawn by a child
- blanket
- snack food such as goldfish or cheerios in small packet
- juice pack
- toothbrush/toothpaste

**CHILD BAG** - (note child size\_\_\_\_\_ and gender M\_\_\_ F\_\_\_)

- Toothbrush and paste
- Comb/brush
- pajamas
- Small toy/book/journal
- Fidget spinners or other fidget toys
- School supplies
- t-shirt
- underwear
- socks
- blanket or small travel pillow
- handmade bracelet
- water bottle
- note of encouragement

**TEEN Bag:** (note teen size\_\_\_\_\_ and gender M\_\_\_ F\_\_\_; *some are adult size*)

- Toothbrush and paste
- Deck of cards
- Water bottle
- T-shirt / soft pull-on shorts
- Socks
- Fidget spinner
- Book (one that your teen would like)
- Note of encouragement
- Be creative - if you have a teen, think of things yours would enjoy

**Elderly Bag:** (note elderly size\_\_\_\_\_ and gender M\_\_\_ F\_\_\_)

- Socks (white)
- T-shirts (Large, XL, 2X or 3X)
- Underwear
- Wipes, ziploc bags
- Lip balm
- Hand sanitizer & lotion
- Sweat pants
- Soft pull-on pants
- Snacks (energy bars, flavored drink packs)
- Paper tablets, pens
- Paperback book
- Stamps
- Magnifying glass
- Costume jewelry
- Disposable razors
- Misc. makeup (powder, lipstick)
- Note of encouragement
- Tea bags, instant coffee packs, sweeteners, creamer/sugar packs
- Reading glasses
- Nail clippers
